- 6. Perform other duties as assigned by the Director, consistent with the goals of the Department (DESE) and the Regional Professional Development Center

- A master's degree in education is required.
- Certification in educational administration is preferred.
- Successful experience as a coach or principal in a Professional Learning Community is preferred.
- Background and experience in elementary or secondary education is preferred.
- Background and skills in presenting, consulting, coaching and facilitating are required.
