The successful applicant will be responsible for teaching courses in Early Childhood Education, Development, Early Literacy, Assessment, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies and expected to possess knowledge in the area of Common Core State Standards, Evaluation, and Assessment in Education.

Candidates must also possess strong verbal and written skills that will assist the unit in its ongoing accreditation data collection and reporting processes. The successful candidate will also be expected to participate in ongoing unit activities, College of Education and University committee appointments, participate in professional organizations, conferences, and produce scholarly articles and publications.

The successful candidate will also possess the dispositions of professionalism, competence, reflection, and the ability to work with diverse populations of students, faculty, and community partners. This individual must be a team player and adhere to policy, procedures and timelines.
