ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY

Harris-Stowe State University seeks applications for a full-time, tenure track, 9-month appointment in its College of Education. The successful applicant will be responsible for teaching courses across the curriculum that prepare perspective teachers to integrate technology in their classroom in early childhood, elementary, middle school and/or secondary and are expected to possess knowledge in the area of Common Core State Standards, Evaluation, and Assessment in Education. In addition, this individual will take the lead in the development and ongoing refinement of the assessment system in teacher preparation.

Candidates must also possess strong verbal and written skills that will lead the unit in its ongoing accreditation procedures, assessment and evaluations, collection and analysis of data, and reporting processes. The successful candidate will also be expected to teach classes, serve on committees, advise students, develop procedures to ensure reliability and validity of assessments; pursue a focused area of research and scholarship that culminates in publications, professional presentations, and submission of grant proposals; hold active membership in relevant professional associations/organizations; serve on committees; and participate in official activities at the department, college and university levels.

The successful candidate will also possess the dispositions of professionalism, competence, reflection, and the ability to work with diverse populations of students, faculty, and community partners. This individual must be a team player and adhere to policy, procedures and timelines.

A PhD/Ed D in Educational Technology or related area, from an accredited institution is required. Candidates who have teacher certification and at least five years of experience teaching in the P-12 setting, at the college/university level, as well as experience teaching online courses, are preferred. Candidates must be prepared to teach day as well as evening and weekend classes.
