Teacher Assistant Requirements

Teacher assistants must meet ONE of the following:

- 1. Have a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential awarded by the Council for Professional Recognition or equivalent.
- 2. Working on either a CDA credential, an AAS degree in Early Care and Education or a B.S. degree in early childhood education, child development, family studies, early childhood special education or elementary education with emphasis in early childhood education (with a minimum of 12 credit hours on transcript).
- 3. Have a degree (associate's or higher) outside of the early childhood field and three or more years of work experience in a NAEYC accredited program.
- 4. Have a degree (associate's or higher) outside of the early childhood field with three or more years of work experience in a non-accredited program and at least **30 contact hours** of relevant training during the past three years.
