Teacher Assistant Requirements

Teacher assistants must meet **ONE** of the following:

1. Have a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential awarded by the Council for Professional Recognition or equivalent.
2. Working on either a CDA credential, an AAS degree in Early Care and Education or a B.S. degree in early childhood education, child development, family studies, early childhood special education or elementary education with emphasis in early childhood education (with at minimum of 12 credit hours on transcript).
3. Have a degree (associate's or higher) outside of the early childhood field and three or more years of work experience in a NAEYC accredited program.
4. Have a degree (associate's or higher) outside of the early childhood field with three or more years of work experience in a non-accredited program and at least **30 contact hours** of relevant training during the past three years.

All applicants must have prior child care experience, knowledge of child development and family dynamics, and past experience working with a diversified population. All positions must be able to be CPR and first aid certified. A criminal and child abuse background investigation will be conducted.
