Procedures for Professional Level Interview (Educational Studies)

Complete the **Application to be considered for an interview.** The following documents must be submitted to the College of Education, **ECEC 200**, to participate in an interview:

- 1. **Application for Admission to Teacher Education.** Submit a completed application to the Educational Studies Program.
- 2. **Personal Background and Professional Goals Statements.** In a few typewritten paragraphs, state important information about your background experiences such as schools attended, special activities, honors received, interests, hobbies, and employment. Describe briefly why you have decided to pursue a degree in Educational Studies.
- 3. Letter of Recommendation: Provided one letter of recommendation from an instructor familiar with your academic abilities.

The Interview: The admission interview is an important element toward admission to the College of Education. It is designed to select students prepared as quality professionals in the field of education. It is expected that students will view this as an important beginning to their professional career. Therefore, you are to present yourself in a professional manner appropriate for the interview at the assigned interview time. All interview candidates are required to complete a spontaneous writing sample on a topic provided immediately prior to the interview. This sample is evaluated on the bases of Standard English, Usage, Grammar, Punctuation, Spelling, Introduction, body, conclusion, and cohesive discussion on topic.

A. Failure to attend a scheduled interview will result in removal from the interview pool for the semester.

Should the writing sample be deemed unacceptable, you will be required to seek assistance from the Academic Resource Center. Sessions will include a pretest, doing assigned work, a posttest, and completing an acceptable essay. Should the interview be deemed unacceptable, you will be required to seek assistance from the Office of Career Services for assistance with interviewing skills. These steps must be completed prior to admission to the College of Education.
