HSSU Partners with Urban K-Life of St. Louis for Annual MLK Day of Service

LOUIS, MO (January 15, 2013) – Harris-Stowe State University will participate in the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. National Day of Service, which has been coordinated by the Corporation for National and Community Service. This annual effort is one that inspires Americans from across the country to come together on the King Holiday to serve their neighbors and communities.

This is the third year that Harris-Stowe has received the grant, which encourages college students to honor the memory, life and work of Dr. King.
