Harris Stowe State University requires all Residential students (regardless of age) to complete a Medical Health History Form before moving on campus. This Form does not require a physical examination from a physician, nor does it require a physician's signature. Listed below you will find all the requirements needed to fulfill the health requirements for residential life at Harris-Stowe State University:

- 1. Send a Completed Medical Health History Form
- Please send a copy of your immunization records. Immunization records (baby shot record) showing 2 MMR's (Mumps, Measles, and Rubella) shots. If you have questions regarding this requirement, please call Residents Life, 314-340-5005.
- 3. If you have had a positive TB Skin Test in the past, you should provide proof of a recent chest x-ray and any treatment received.
- You are required to either obtain the Meningococcal vaccination <u>OR</u> sign a waiver declining the vaccination.

You may call the Resident Life Department at (314) 340-5300 to check the status of your health information. If your information is incomplete, a letter will be sent stating what is missing. Remember to keep a copy for your records. <u>Your prompt reply to this request</u> will prevent any delays in your housing assignment.
