

FAFSA Terms & Links

The following table contains additional information about specific FAFSA topics. Please review each description carefully and click on the link in the last column if necessary. Please note that if the link directs you to a form/worksheet, it must be completed and returned to the Office of Financial Assistance as soon as possible. Feel free to follow up with a financial aid counselor if you have additional questions after reviewing each description.

Contact	Description	Link
Bachelors' Degree Earned	You reported on your FAFSA that you have earned a Bachelors' degree. This makes you ineligible for Federal Pell Grant, but you may be eligible for Federal Student Loans. If you do not have a Bachelors' Degree, please update your FAFSA.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
Data Mismatch on FAFSA	The Department of Education has reported to us that you have reported data on your FAFSA that does not match their records. Until this is resolved you are not eligible for Federal Student Aid.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
DOB Wrong on FAFSA	The Department of Education has indicated that your Date of Birth was reported incorrectly on your FAFSA. You can update this on your own, or provide documents to the Office of Financial Assistance and we will make the correction for you. Until this is resolved you are not eligible for Federal Student Aid.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
FAFSA Received	HSSU has received your application for federal student aid.	N/A
FAFSA Rejected	The Department of Education has notified us that your FAFSA has been rejected. You are required to provide additional documents to the Office of Financial Assistance or log back into the FAFSA to correct the information you previously provide.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
Parent Signature Needed (or) Student Signature Needed	You have completed the FAFSA, however either you or one of your parents has not signed the form. You can log back in the FAFSA and apply the signature electronically.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
Ques#31 on FAFSA	You reported on your FAFSA that you did not meet the requirements for federal student aid due to a drug issue.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
Social Security Card	Due to a discrepancy on your FAFSA, we are required to collect a copy of your Social Security Card.	www.fafsa.ed.gov
